What Code Girls Do:

Real skills, business savvy, and practical approaches are the watchwords of CGU foundation efforts.

In weekly after school meetings (or twice weekly lunch time meetings), the girls design and code a working App which they present to peers and teachers—a developmental step to prepare for local, state, regional, and national competition. At this development stage, the girls will have done market research for their App Concept, they will have written and error-trapped the App code, and ended with a working prototype. At the Northwest Regional App Challenge, the girls present their prototype to an audience and a panel of technical judges—think science fair for Apps. The prizes are more than “bragging” rights”; they can win scholarship money too. \$5,000, \$2500, and \$1000 scholarships are awarded to first, second, and third place teams, respectively.
